Financial Millstones

Take money, for instance. The advent of the credit card and Internet finance has opened up a vast treasure house of "today" consumption. Get it today, pay later (if ever). We are swamping ourselves in debt. Bankruptcy, once seen as highly ignominious, is prevalent and often chosen as a means to escape paying debts. Homes, cars, TVs, computers, fridges, boats and even holidays are bought on credit without any real consideration of the financial millstone that buyers are tying round their own necks. We would do well to heed the counsel of Scripture: "Owe no one anything except to love one another" and "the borrower is servant to the lender."

Selling Off Our Assets

Our nation, too, is caught up in the same malady The national debt continues to mount – now over \$330 billion - despite efforts by the government to hold it in check. Unwisely, however, they are selling off our assets at an alarming rate so that in the not-too-distant future we will be completely foreign owned. Over the last few years governments have sold off a whole raft of public utilities and enterprises such as water, sewerage, shipping, airport, hospitals, prisons, power supplies, Telstra, tourist resorts, defence maintenance, coastal patrols, railways, ferries, buses, satellites, ports, oil, gas, minerals and even workers' superannuation schemes. Whereas once we had the highest standard of living in the world, we are now 33rd and dropping further Just how long can we keep this up? Not surprisingly our politicians continue to feed from the public trough with huge salary increases and perks that turn the rest of us green with envy, apparently unaware that the good ship Australia is sinking fast beneath the waves of international debt We must acknowledge that in God's Kingdom there is no debt; but He expects us to act justly, love mercy and to walk humbly with Him.

Have It Now

Then there is the matter of sexual relations. Once upon a time the code of ethical behaviour decreed that young couples refrain from sex until they married. It was all a matter of self-control. But now everyone must have it NOW. Consider the demands for rights. Protesters march down the streets of our cities shouting, "What do we want?" "We want our rights." "When do we want them?" "NOW!" Not only must we have instant coffee but instant everything else as well. The "have it now" philosophy that is so prevalent today breeds nothing good. It flies in the face of all the traditional values. What is worth having is worth waiting for Yet the impermanence of existence with its diabolical threats of international terrorism, nuclear war, AIDS, environmental devastation and escalating crime coupled with unemployment and family breakdown have undermined the stability of life and the very meaning of

existence But why? Why is life seen as so uncertain? It was not so in the past. Past generations enjoyed a trusting and dependent faith in God that anchored their souls to reality, purpose and hope for the future. Where is that faith now? It still exists It is still real. It is there for the asking. In fact "faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God." In particular young people have been deceived into seeking happiness by throwing off self-control and plunging into an orgy of self-gratification of their natural desires.

Whether people realise it or not the world is fast approaching the end of the age Jesus Christ is coming again. His followers know it The Bible teaches it. The powers of darkness realise it and are feverishly spreading a vile campaign of lies, deception and hatred because they know the time is short.
