And we said nothing in protest. Then Lionel Murphy enacted the Family Law Act and divorce became as easy as falling off a log Consequently now more than a third of marriages end in divorce and countless children are spending some or all of their formative years in one-parent families with all the trauma and deprivation that entails. No one argued with him. Then the academics decided that all moral issues were not matters of black and white but had to be seen in various shades of grey. So young minds were turned to mush when it came to separating right from wrong. They soon came to believe that "if it feels good it must be right".
